associated business areas, unless automated and digital solutions are used. Within the concept CPS®miSELF, it is possible to integrate C-Parts, standard parts and special parts. It also allows the companies to handle non-Würth products as well as A- and B-Parts, for which mostly other purchasing processes are applicable and the application for the purpose of intralogistics itself is required. In this case, customers can manage all items through a single tool. For users, this digital management indicates significantly reduced efforts in procurement and supplier management, a comprehensive service for all items, full transparency of inventory of items, suppliers and storage locations and maximum security of supply. The basis for CPS®miSELF is a web-based platform in combination with RFID Kanban solutions and related hardware such as bins, labels and racks from Würth Industrie Service. The result: a digital management tool and only one system for all types of parts – setting a course for the future of supply.

The visitors will not only be introduced to the innovations at the trade fair booth, but also to tailor-made logistics procurement and supply concepts in C-Parts management.
